"Nothing but the Blood of Jesus"

At the beginning of summer I received notice from the American Red Cross that my double red cell blood donation they call "POWER RED" had been administered to a patient. The notice was accompanied by a brief thank you for my donation. It felt sort of good to know that my blood had helped someone. For a minute I felt like I had done something big, but "I" was not the operative word. Almost anyone's "O+" blood would have been just as effective. My effort was not the point. I was not capable of helping someone directly in this way. I couldn't have saved anyone who had blood loss on my own. I could not transfer my blood to them. I did nothing. But the nature of the blood was the key. It's type, constituent qualities, and the life giving nature of the hemoglobin was able to do something miraculous.

In 1876 the famous hymn Nothing But the Blood of Jesus illustrated the powerful truths of <u>Hebrews 9</u>. Namely that "...under the law almost everything is purified with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins." (Hebrews 9:22). The author also references that the blood of Jesus is one sacrifice for all time, effective alone to address our sin problem. (Continue reading here...)

High school fall sports officially began on August 14th for soccer, volleyball, and cross country. Soccer is currently scheduled to open their season on September 5th at Sweet Home at 6:00 and their home opener on September 11th at 4:30 vs Kennedy. They had their previous opener cancelled and we are looking to schedule another game. Volleyball will open their season with a jamboree at Santiam on August 24th. Their home opener is on August 29th vs Blanchet with the JV game at 4:30 followed by the varsity at 6:00. Cross country opens their season on August 31st at the Darrel Deedon Invite at Cascade HS. Middle school fall sports are allowed to begin practice on August 21st but might not begin until the start of school. If your child is wanting to play soccer or volleyball and needs information please email me. Volleyball's first game is home vs Jefferson on September 8th. Soccer's first game is September 13th at OSD at 4:00.

All athletes (7th grade and up) are required to have a sports physical on file with the athletic director that is current within the past 2 years. Returning athletes parents should have received an email the first week of June letting you know if your child needs an updated physical. If you are not sure if you need one, please email me ASAP. Welcome to Preschool

Hi Preschool Parents! The start of our school year is right around the corner! Here are some things you may be wondering about: 1. How do I know what class my preschooler will be in? You will be contacted before Back to School Open House to let you know what class your child has been placed in and which classroom to visit on that day. 2. Do I really need to go to Open House? What happens if we can't make it? Yes! Open House is a really important day where your child will be able to meet his/her teacher, become familiar with the classroom while accompanied by you and meet a few friends. It's also a great way to bring in school supplies without all the craziness of the first day of school. Teachers will also have important paperwork to give you that will need to be filled out and signed before your child starts school.
