### **Summer Sports Activities**

It's hard to believe that summer is already halfway through. Here are some summer activities that are going on at East Linn Christian. There will be a softball camp for 3rd-8th grades on July 31-August 2 at Christopher Columbus Park. Cost is \$55 and includes a shirt if registered by July 16th. Proceeds will go to the softball program. High school volleyball is currently having open gyms on Mondays from 7:00-9:00am and Wednesdays and Fridays from 5:00-7:00pm. Girls high school basketball is having open gyms on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:00-10:00am. High school soccer is having open fields on Tuesdays from 8:30-10:00am and Thursdays from 6:30-8:00pm. MS volleyball is planning open gyms on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 10:00-noon beginning August 15th until the start

of school. Official practices for MS volleyball will start on the first day of school. The first date allowed for official high school practice for cross country, volleyball, and soccer is Monday, August 14th. Times for these practices will be announced through the Game Changer app. If you have a student-athlete interested in one of these sports who is not on the summer team app through Game Changer, let me know and I will get them added so they can keep up on current information. MS cross country and soccer practice will be announced later but will start no earlier than August 21st. For athletes in 7th-12th grade who participated in sports at ELC last year, you should have received an email around the beginning of June letting you know whether or not your child needs an updated sports physical. If you have a son or daughter who will be new to ELC sports this school year, they will need to get a sports physical to me by the start of practice. I am excited to welcome Kassie Denue to our coaching staff as the new varsity volleyball head coach. In addition, Angie Kropf is moving from MS volleyball to take over as the JV head coach and Jacque Stutzman is moving from assistant to head MS volleyball coach. We are also currently looking for an assistant high school volleyball coach.
