

From “The Case for Sanctification”

This past week the East Linn Christian family enjoyed three days of senior speeches in which staff, students, and family members got to witness a culminating academic event for 28 soon-to-be graduates. What we witnessed was by no means the end of their individual growth, but a benchmark moment of their first approximately 18 years of life. It was wonderful.

Senior speeches are somewhat different for every student. For some it's just the last in a long line of high school requirements that will resume next fall when they start college. For others it may be the last time they enter into the classic academic realm before heading off to work or a focused trade program. A third group find themselves battling through the almost paralyzing fear of standing in front of others and speaking publicly. And a fourth group fears an unknown question that may derail their arguments and possibly sink their chance for graduation. But year after year they all manage to make it, overcoming the trepidation of standing alone before an audience and a panel who they know will ask them in one way or another to defend their topic of choice. What none of the seniors tend to realize is that there is no such fear among the audience watching, the panel questioning, or Mrs. Davis who assigns the final grade. For this crowd it's all about celebrating what we already are certain will happen.
