Sports Updates

Winter sports are wrapping up as high school has completed their regular schedules and are preparing for post-season play. Both our boys and girls varsity basketball teams finished the regular season with league records of 15-1 and both finished in 1st place in the north division of the Valley Coast Conference and 2nd overall. They advance to the final four of the league tournament to be played on February 16-17 at Sutherlin High School. Both teams are guaranteed a first round State playoff game and the winner of the tournament will be guaranteed a home game for the first round of State along with the 4 highest ranked teams in the state who do not win one of the 4 league tournaments. Our girls are currently ranked 6th in the state and our boys are ranked 7th in 2A. The boys will play a first round State game on Friday, February 23 and the girls will play on Saturday, February 24. Time and place will be determined by Sunday, February 18th. The winners of those games will advance to the State tournament in Pendleton on February 29-March 2. We have traditionally closed school when both basketball teams advance to Pendleton to allow our students and staff the opportunity to go support them. Our boys JV ended the season with a record of 13-8 and won their final 8 games. The girls JV finished the season with a record of 17-3 which is the best JV record in recent history, if not school history. Our 4 middle school boys teams are also having a successful season that will wrap up on February

26th. Congratulations to Daisy Lalonde and Seth Cox who were part of the District Champion boys and girls swim teams at Sweet Home and to Angus Smith who placed 5th in the District wrestling for Central Linn. High school spring sports begin on February 26 with baseball, golf, track, and the return of softball. Make sure that your child has a current (within 2 years) sports physical before the start of the season.
